A PROCLAMATION

United Nations Day

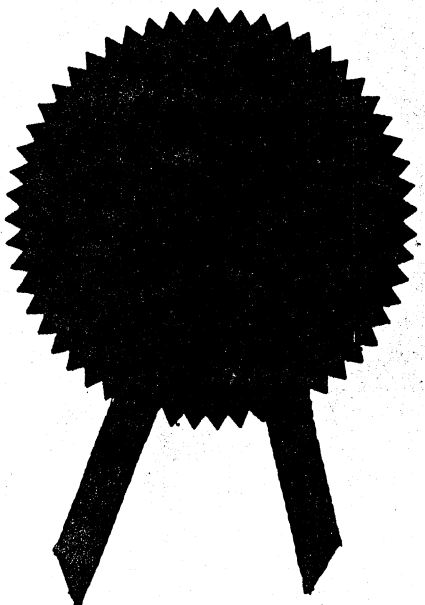
WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the United Nations has designated October 24 as United Nations Day;

WHEREAS, all countries that collaborate with the principles embodied in the United Nations will cooperate in the adequate celebration of this date;

WHEREAS, the people of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico have absolute faith in the principles inspiring the United Nations, and know that cooperation and mutual understanding constitute the best way to achieve peace and security to all people;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim October 24, as United Nations day and urge all officials, state and municipal, all associations, and the public in general to help honor the ideals of the United Nations and assist in their propagation and growth.
