American Legion Days

WHEREAS, during the days between March 15 and 17, it will be 33 years since the Convention in Paris in which the American Legion was organized;

WHEREAS, this year the American Legion plans to celebrate meetings, ceremonies and acts commemorative of the date of its organization,

WHEREAS, deservedly the celebration of the thirty third anniversary of the American Legion should have the official acknowledgment of the Government of Puerto Rico;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the days 15, 16 and 17 of the next month of March as American Legion Days, and urge all my fellow citizens to cooperate by all means possible to the success and deserved triumph of the acts and ceremonies that in the course of the dates pointed out should organize and celebrate the American Legion.
