A PROCLAMATION

Education Week

WHEREAS, a well organized and guided public school is an essential factor in the making of conscious citizens capable of living in democratic harmony;

WHEREAS, contributing according to his abilities and resources for the maintenance, proper functioning and improvement of material conditions and spiritual values of the schools, is a personal responsibility shared by every citizen;

WHEREAS, only a people well informed about the programs, aims, needs, and the bonds of friendliness and cooperation that should be maintained between homes, schools and the community, can intelligently support a good educational system;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the week of November 8 to 14 as Education Week, and cordially invite all citizens to visit the schools of the Commonwealth during these days, so as to acquaint themselves with the work being done therein, the problems which they confront, and the spirit which animates them, and to help with their honest criticism toward the better attainment of their outstanding aims.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to be affixed, at the City of San Juan, this 5th day of November, A.D., nineteen hundred and fifty-four.
