A PROCLAMATION

Dairy Industry Month

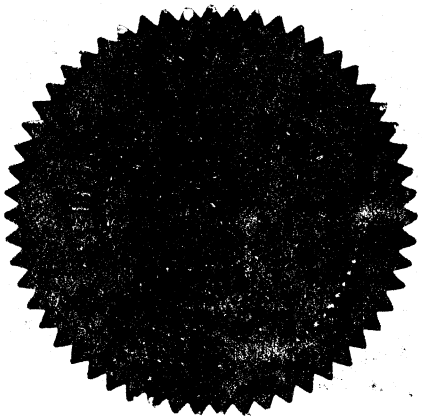
WHEREAS, milk and all milk products have been recognized as indispensable to the health of every living creature;

WHEREAS, the cattle industry is the second agricultural enterprise in Puerto Rico's economy, and provides employment and means of living to thousands of individuals;

WHEREAS, it is convenient to establish in Puerto Rico the practice of dedicating a month each year to emphasize the advantages of the dairy industry, because of its great contribution to the general welfare of the community and also as a means of promoting the industry's continual growth;

WHEREAS, the month of June has been considered as the most appropriate in which to honor said industry and all those who work in it;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the month of June, 1955, as the one best suited to encourage the use of fresh milk and all milk products, and I request all business and civic groups to cooperate in its observance, so as to promote the people's health and succeed in attaining a more flourishing and generalized dairy industry.
