A PROCLAMATION

Week of the Puerto Rican Family

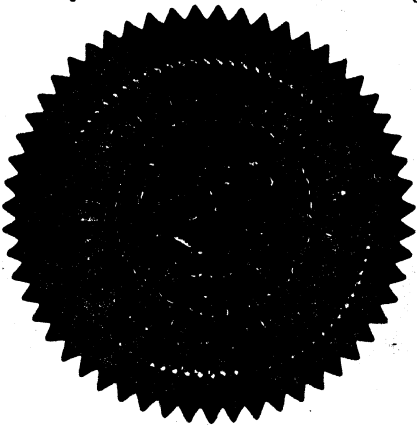
WHEREAS: The greatest concern of the Government of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico is to attain and maintain high standards of living which will insure the highest possible level of personal and collective welfare of all Puerto Ricans;

WHEREAS: The Government of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico recognized that in order to attain and maintain the highest possible level of welfare of Puerto Ricans, it is necessary that they enjoy a happy home life, for which there have been established, and are being enlarged and established every day, more programs for the strengthening of family life;

WHEREAS: Various public and private agencies, civic and social groups and private citizens have been, and are, carrying out programs of study and activities so as to analyze and fight the factors which affect adversely the happy family life;

WHEREAS: It is necessary that the entire Puerto Rican community be conscious of the need to join efforts to attain the highest level of stability and happiness of the Puerto Rican homes;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ROBERTO SANCHEZ VILELLA, Acting Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, proclaim the week from June 25 to July 1st., 1955, Week of the Puerto Rican Family, and request all the public officials, the industries, the religious, civic and professional groups, and all private citizens to give their whole-hearted cooperation to the acts which, under the auspices of the Puerto Rican Institute of Family Relations, shall be held during said week, so that everyone may contribute more efficiently towards attaining more stable and happier homes.
