A PROCLAMATION

Development Week

WHEREAS, the welfare and happiness of its people constitute the main purpose of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico;

WHEREAS, to that end, the Battle of Production has been going on for many years, through which we have achieved more employment opportunities, higher salaries, more schools, roads, hospitals, and a marked increase in the production and income of the people;

WHEREAS, the program of the Economic Development Administration is key element in such progress;

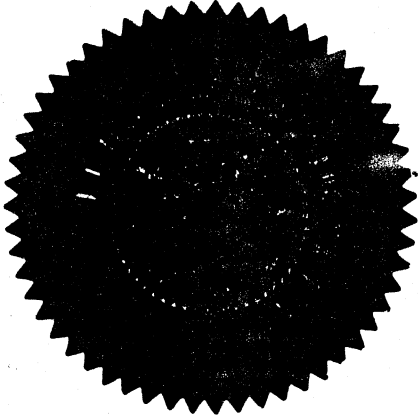
WHEREAS, said progress is a result of the good collaboration and exemplary solidarity which, for the attainment of said purpose has always existed between the Economic Development Administration and other Government agencies, departments and organizations, such as the Government Development Bank, the Water Resources Authority, the Aqueduct and Sewer Authority, and, in fact, all the instrumentalities under Government Supervision, which represent the efforts and solidary will of our people working toward their own improvement;

WHEREAS, the 400th. factory of the industrialization program in Puerto Rico will open during the week from May 6 to 12, 1956;

WHEREAS, more or less at the same time, the income from industry will match the income from agriculture, which for such a long while constituted the only source of income to the great majority of our people, and it is the main purpose of the Government to do everything possible for it to continue increasing and getting stronger similarly with the industry;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, declare that the above stated facts should be made known, and to that end, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the Constitution and the laws of the country, do proclaim the week from May 6 to 12, 1956 as

Development Week, and I urge all my fellow citizens to get familiar through all their possible means with the promising progress achieved, to think about what that progress has meant in the everyday life of our good people so that we all may feel strong, to undertake with renewed strength all the great work that we have to do yet.
