A PROCLAMATION

Calling a Special Session
of the Legislative Assembly

WHEREAS, there being several business public interest that require action by the Legislative Assembly;

THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, in virtue of the authority conferred on me by the Constitution, now call the members of the Legislative Assembly for a special session that shall begin Monday, July 29, in the Capitol, to consider the following business and to adopt adequate means to attend to same.

1. To amend Act 279 of April 5, 1946, known as the Automobiles Act in whatever it relates, to the power of the Secretary of Public Works to regulate the speed motor vehicles in rural zones.
2. To consider the repeal of Act 53, approved June 10, 1948.
3. To amend Act 67 of June 10, 1953 related to Coffee Insurance.
