A PROCLAMATION

To conform to our people's traditional solemn observance of Easter week, I deem it appropriate to suspend government operations from Thursday, April 3rd, at twelve noon, and all day Friday, April 4th.

As the requirements of public service are such that some operations and employees must be retained. I hope that the heads of departments, agencies, and other Government instrumentalities; will make pertinent arrangements to retain in their respective agencies a minimum personnel to attend to any urgent business that may be brought to their attention in accordance with public service needs.
