A PROCLAMATION

Special Session of the Legislative Assembly. Third extension to the Notice of Meeting Issued on June 13, 1958. Specifying several additional matters to be considered by the Legislative Assembly convened to meet on June 17.

WHEREAS, several matters of importance for the public interest, in addition to the one specified in the original Notice of Meeting, those specified in the first extension and that specified in the second one, require action from the Legislative Assembly in this Special Session;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, by virtue of the authority conferred upon me by the Constitution, do hereby submit to said Legislative Assembly, for its consideration and action, the following matters:

1. Legislation authorizing the employment of veterinaries whether American or Foreign citizens.
2. Legislation authorizing the utilization of determined persons to carry out certain practices of veterinary science under the supervision of authorized veterinarians (PS 312).
3. New Public Service Act (PC 247).

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to be affixed, at the City of San Juan, this 27th day of June, A.D., nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
