A PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF  
PUERTO RICO

WORLD DAY OF URBANITY

WHEREAS, Saturday, November 8 is the World Day of Urbanity;

WHEREAS, the principles and ideals of Urbanity as factors of human brotherhood are commemorated universally on that date;

WHEREAS, the unity and solidarity of the peoples of America depend on the cultural exchange;

WHEREAS, the people of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico believe that the principles and ideals of Urbanity unite the Puerto Rican people to the cultural life in the Hemisphere;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, hereby proclaim that the WORLD DAY OF URBANITY be commemorated on the 8th day of November through fitting ceremonies, to the end of obtaining greater participation from the citizenry in the problems of planning.

That for the good of this good cause, our press and radio, as well as our civic and cultural associations, consider the convenience of holding activities and programs stressing the great significance of this movement.
