A PROCLAMATION

Human Rights Day

WHEREAS, The Universal Declaration of Human Rights was adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations on December 10, 1948; and,

WHEREAS, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights proclaims that recognition of the inherent dignity and the equal and inalienable rights of all members of the human family is the foundation of freedom, justice and peace in the world, and declares that the basis of the authority of all government shall be the will of the people; and,

WHEREAS, all free peoples ought to do everything possible to bring recognition of these rights to persons who do not now enjoy them, including observances of this anniversary; and,

WHEREAS, the President of the United States annually proclaims the anniversary of the adoption of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights as HUMAN RIGHTS DAY, and urges its observance in American communities;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim December 10, 1958, as Human Rights Day and urge all citizens of Puerto Rico to join in appropriate observances of this occasion to insure the achievement and protection of these fundamental freedoms for all.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to be affixed, at the City of San Juan, this 1st day of December, A. D. nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
