A PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE COMMONWEALTH
OF PUERTO RICO

REGISTRATION OF VOTERS OF BOTH SEXES FOR THE GENERAL
ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 1960

WHEREAS, pursuant to Act No. 19, approved June 10, 1939, establishing a system of registration of voters, as amended by Act No. 1 of February 13, 1952, I approved the Resolution of the Commonwealth Board of Elections fixing the days for the registration of voters of both sexes who are not duly registered for the general elections corresponding to the year 1960, as follows: Saturday, January 30, 1960 for the female voters, and Sunday, January 31 for the registration of male voters.

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, pursuant to the provisions of the said act, hereby announce through this proclamation that the registration of female voters shall take place on Saturday, January 30, 1960, and the registration of male voters in Puerto Rico shall take place on Sunday, January 31, 1960, beginning at one (1:00) o'clock in the afternoon of each day, so that on said days those persons who are not duly registered as voters and are legally entitled to registration may be so registered, in order that they may vote in the general elections corresponding to 1960.
