A PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE COMMONWEALTH
OF PUERTO RICO

HOME DEMONSTRATION CLUBS WEEK

WHEREAS, through the Home Demonstration Clubs our housewives receive valuable practical teachings on health care, nutrition, house decoration, the good utilization of money, food production and preservation, the good utilization of time and good family relations;

WHEREAS, the Home Demonstration Clubs work for the economic, social, civic and cultural improvement of Puerto Rican housewives, and contribute effectively to the family welfare;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, hereby proclaim the week from May 1 to 7 as the "Home Demonstration Clubs Week" in acknowledgment of their worthy contribution to the welfare of the Puerto Rican family; and I urge the press, radio and television to join in this acknowledgment by publishing the many activities held; and I urge, furthermore, all the housewives not belonging to the Home Demonstration Clubs to join them during this week.
