A PROCLAMATION

Social Security Week

WHEREAS, the President of the United States approved the Social Security Act on August 14, 1935; and

WHEREAS, the Social Security Law has provided partial security in cases where a worker or his family lose their income through retirement, disability or death; and has, moreover, contributed to the security of children through programs for dependent children, maternal and child health, handicapped children and child welfare, and has made cash payments and rendered other services to the aged, blind, handicapped and unemployed; and

WHEREAS, million of workers and their widows, children, etc., including many Puerto Ricans, received aid during the past twenty-five years under the provisions of the Social Security Act; and

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, in commemoration of the 25th Anniversary of the approval of the Social Security Act, do hereby proclaim August 14-20, 1960, as Social Security Week in Puerto Rico, and urge all my fellow citizens to observe with appropriate ceremonies the commemoration of the approval of the said Act.
