A PROCLAMATION

Pharmacy Week

WHEREAS, the pharmaceutical class of Puerto Rico works continuously for the betterment of public health;

WHEREAS, the preparation, preservation and selling of drugs and other medicines at the drugstores of Puerto Rico, constitute a great responsibility;

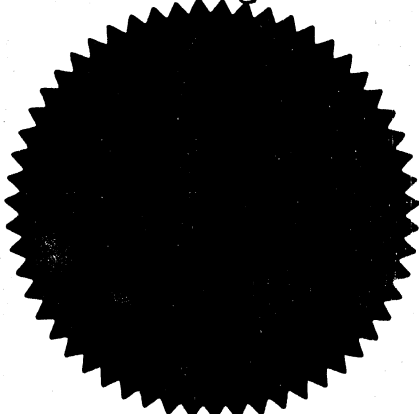
WHEREAS, it is the function of the pharmaceutical class to render the best professional services to the community, in keeping with the highest principles on ethics;

WHEREAS, for the best fulfillment of their activities to a better public health, it is essential that the community understand the great responsibility that pharmacies have in Puerto Rico;

WHEREAS, the pharmaceutical class of the States of the American Union and of the other countries of the Hemisphere, fosters the celebration of acts that define to the public the objectives and functions of the pharmaceutical class;

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the people have a better understanding of the objectives leading to a better public health, stressing the responsibilities involved in the use and misuse of drugs, and on the mission of the drugstores in the community.

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim September 18-24, 1960, as Pharmacy Week in Puerto Rico, and I urge all my fellow citizens to cooperate with the pharmaceutical class in the celebration of all acts during the said week.
